In 1991 further city records were brought to the fourth floor. Apparently partial weeding and consolidation of the two accessions took place. Some labels of the 1981 classification remain, but it cannot be assumed that the original contents of the boxes remain.

The 16 boxes of mayor and council records were reduced to 2 boxes. The clerk comptroller records were consolidated and listed a file folder heading level. The public works and city engineer records were roughly sorted into a series, the boxes labelled and numbered as a series. The series also contains extraneous material.
