General Description

These papers consist of 14 cubic-foot boxes of the files deposited at Queen's Archives by F.W. Gibson, author of Volume II and co-editor of Volume I of the Queen's University history. The files have been placed in the boxes by Professor Gibson and they have been listed as received. The rough order is as follows:

Boxes 1 to 8: preparatory material for Volume II in rough chronological order.

Boxes 8 to 10: drafts of chapters of Volume II.

Boxes 11 and 12: further material and notes in alphabetical order.

Boxes 13 and 14: Correspondence and details on publication of Volumes I and II.

It is proposed that the papers be kept unchanged until they have been appraised; and, after appraisal that copies of material readily available from the Queen's Archives or Library be noted and removed.
